

Start time

Arrival at school is for a 09.00am start time. Children should arrive promptly and will be welcomed by a member of SLT at their allocated door at 9.00 am. Children will then make their way to their classroom to be met by their class teacher. Children will be dismissed by their class teacher at the end of the school day.

P.E. days

Children should wear their P.E. Kit on their class P.E. day consisting of a white polo shirt/plain white t-shirt, school sweater or school hoodie and shorts/leggings/joggers. We must highlight the importance of this for this session and ask for your support.

• Children are welcome to join staff in our Festive Dress Down Day. They may come to school wearing either a festive/wintry jumper or something bright or seasonal, eg, a hat, tinsel. All children will take part in our Winter Snow Dash, organised by Pupil Parliamentl and there will be a collection for Strathcarron Hospice on this day.

Tuesday 17 December

• Theatre Visit: M and M Productions Theatre Company will visit school on Tuesday 17 December with their performance of Beauty & The Beast. This is always an exciting event for the children and time for the whole school to be together. In previous years, we have been able to fund the cost of the performance from our school fund but this year we are not in a position to do so. The cost will be £4 per child. Our preferred method of payment is by ParentPay, or alternatively a letter will come home with a tear off slip for you to send in your payment.
