Week beginning 29/04/24- Transition Project

A transition project will be emailed out to all nurseries. The context for this topic will be based around the book "Colour Monster Goes to School". The project will be sent out to all of our nurseries. This project will be started in nursery, there will be a wee activity for parents to do with their child over the summer holiday and then it will be carried on and completed the first weeks in Primary 1. The activity for parents to complete will be given to you by your child's nursery.
